



In a deafening noise of chainsaws, loggers happily humming as they cut down trees to be used as decor for a fashion show. A contemporary cartoon satire, in the form of a burlesque action musical tragicomedy, leads us into a delirious whirlwind of chain reactions as chaotic as they are grotesque.

Suki self-produced from 98 of the animated shorts including Reflets selected in Dresden in 2006. In 2013, supported by the CNC and Pictanovo, N'Djekoh will be selected in Annecy then included in the program Les nouveaux visages de l'animation française. In 2017 he co-founded Utopi and directed an animated fable that will be selected in fifty festivals, included in the L'Extra Court catalog and will participate in the short film festival. After directing a music video and animated sequences for the theater, Suki releases in 2021 "Mondo Domino", co-produced by Utopi, Arte and Pictanovo, with the support of the CNC.





At some point there are already those who sleep, who read, who date. The environment is increasingly fragmented. In the end, only dirty dishes and silence are left.








Big Heinrich Kim Collmer, Lars Kreyssig Germany | 2019

Sumito was born in Hokkaido, 1980. He lives and works in Nagano











Topos Max Bodendorf Germany | 2021

Noorda was designer for the Dutch Broadcast cooperation and pioneer of CGI in the Netherlands in the eighties. He makes independent productions for two decades now. Within art movement Tropism he makes animation films, documentaries, fine art, light installations, VR projects and is curator of exhibitions.










Lame Dust Aleksandra Maximova (Abramova) Russian Federation | 2021







In practice, the Act banned entry to all ethnically Chinese immigrants besides diplomats, and prohibited existing immigrants from obtaining citizenship. Robert Chang details the lasting impact the Act had on immigrant rights and freedoms.

The film was created by Zoe Armit while studying at University For The Creative Arts, using recordings from an interview with A. Hutchinson.








Notun Fasal (New Harvest) Sovan Dutta , Anindita Dutta. Sawanti Das India | 2020




Amor Encerrado is a Spanish animated short film about a passionate Janitor who finds himself at the center of a Telenovela wedding scandal with his cleaning supplies.


